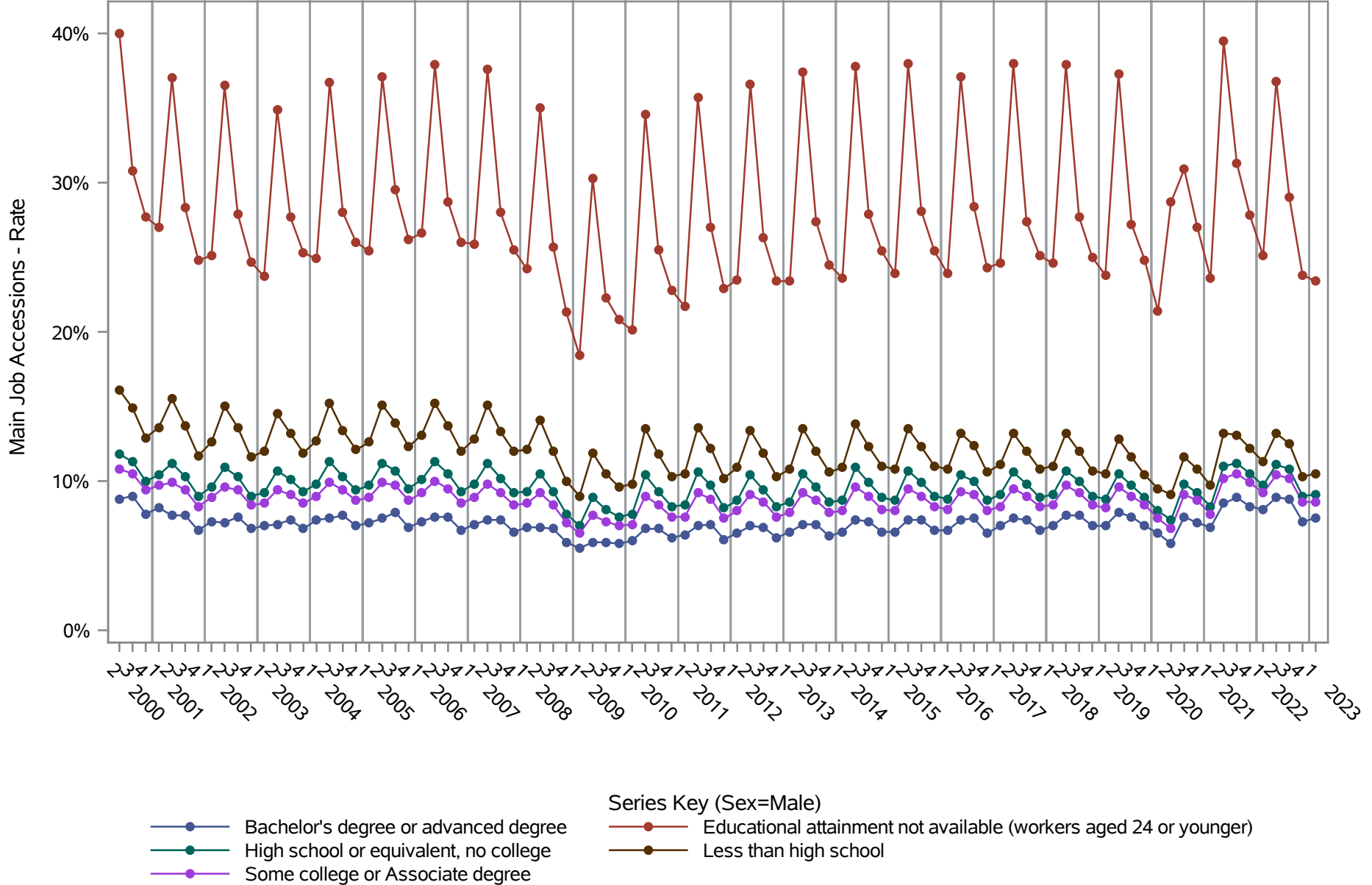

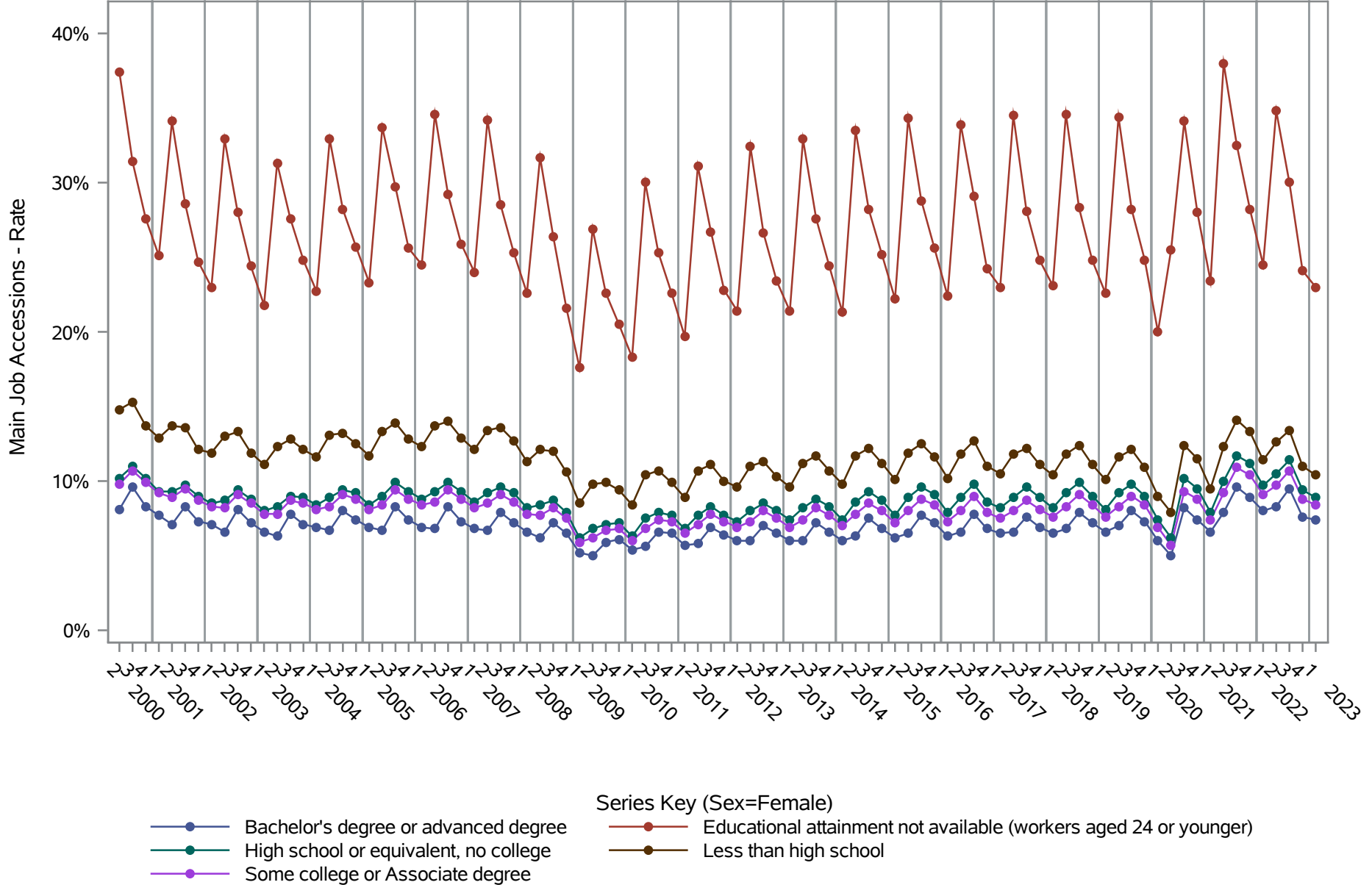
## Main Job Accessions (Not Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (1 of 2) Sex=Male

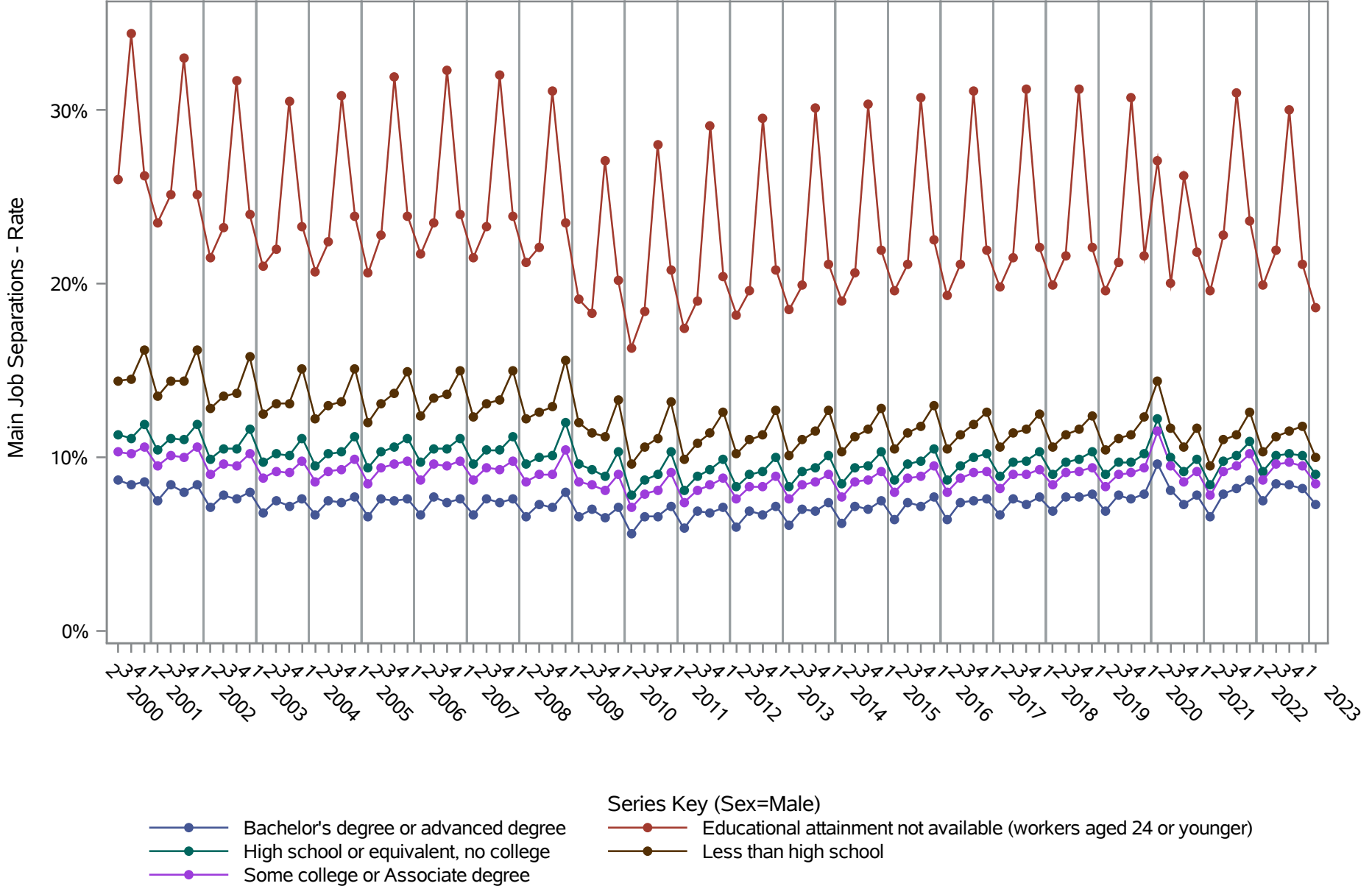
## Main Job Accessions (Not Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (2 of 2) Sex=Female

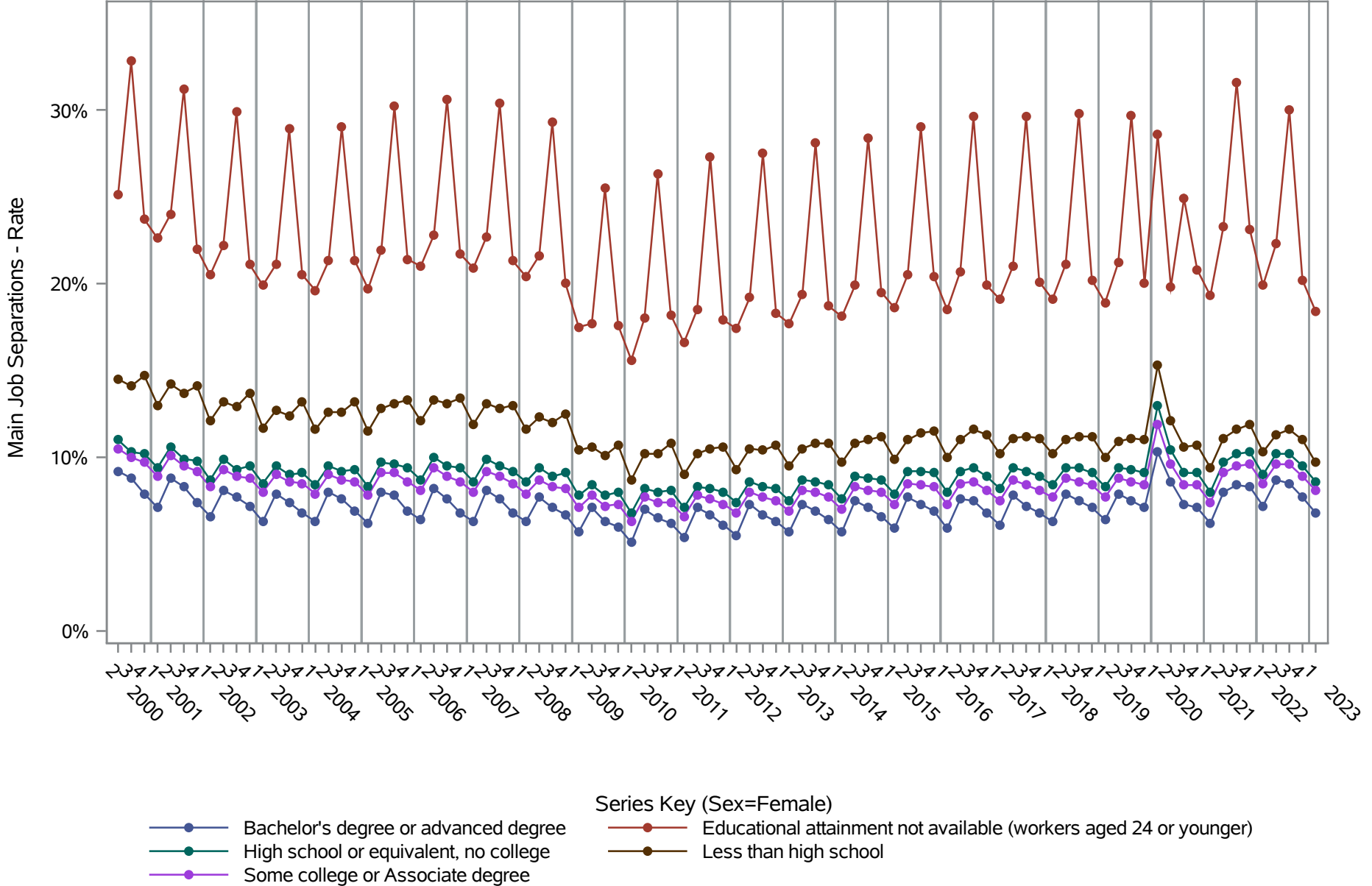

## Main Job Separations (Not Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (1 of 2) Sex=Male



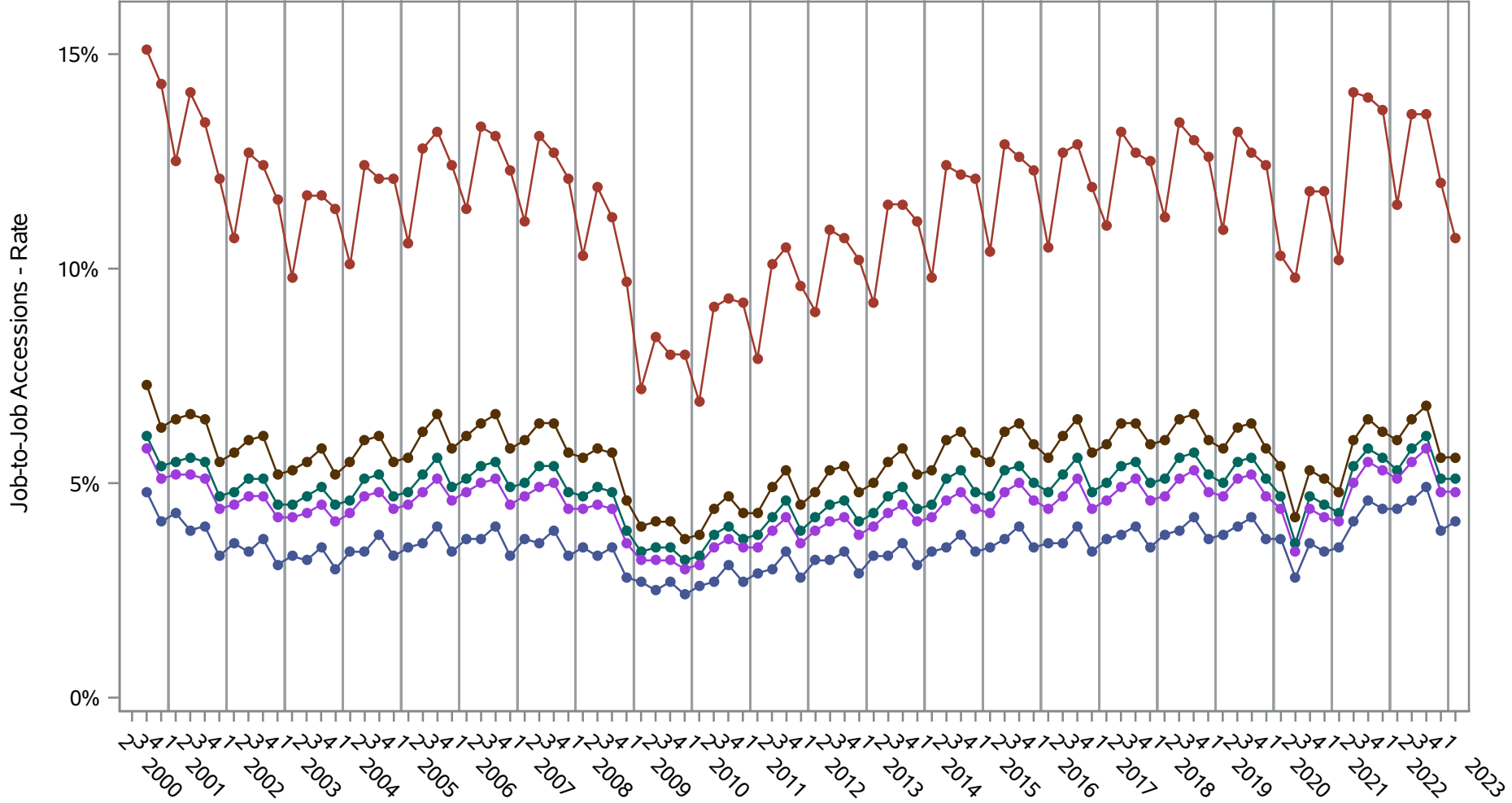

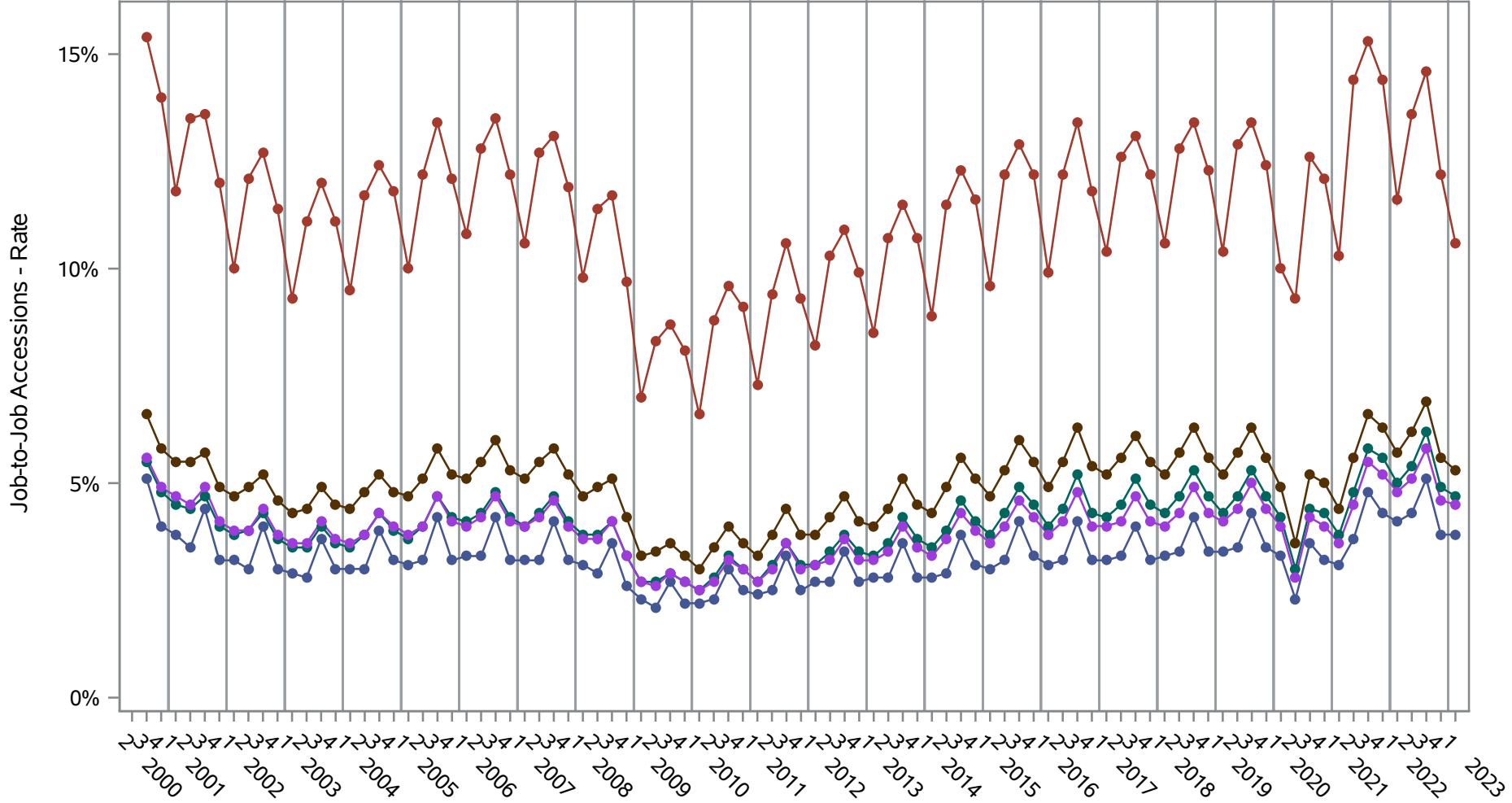

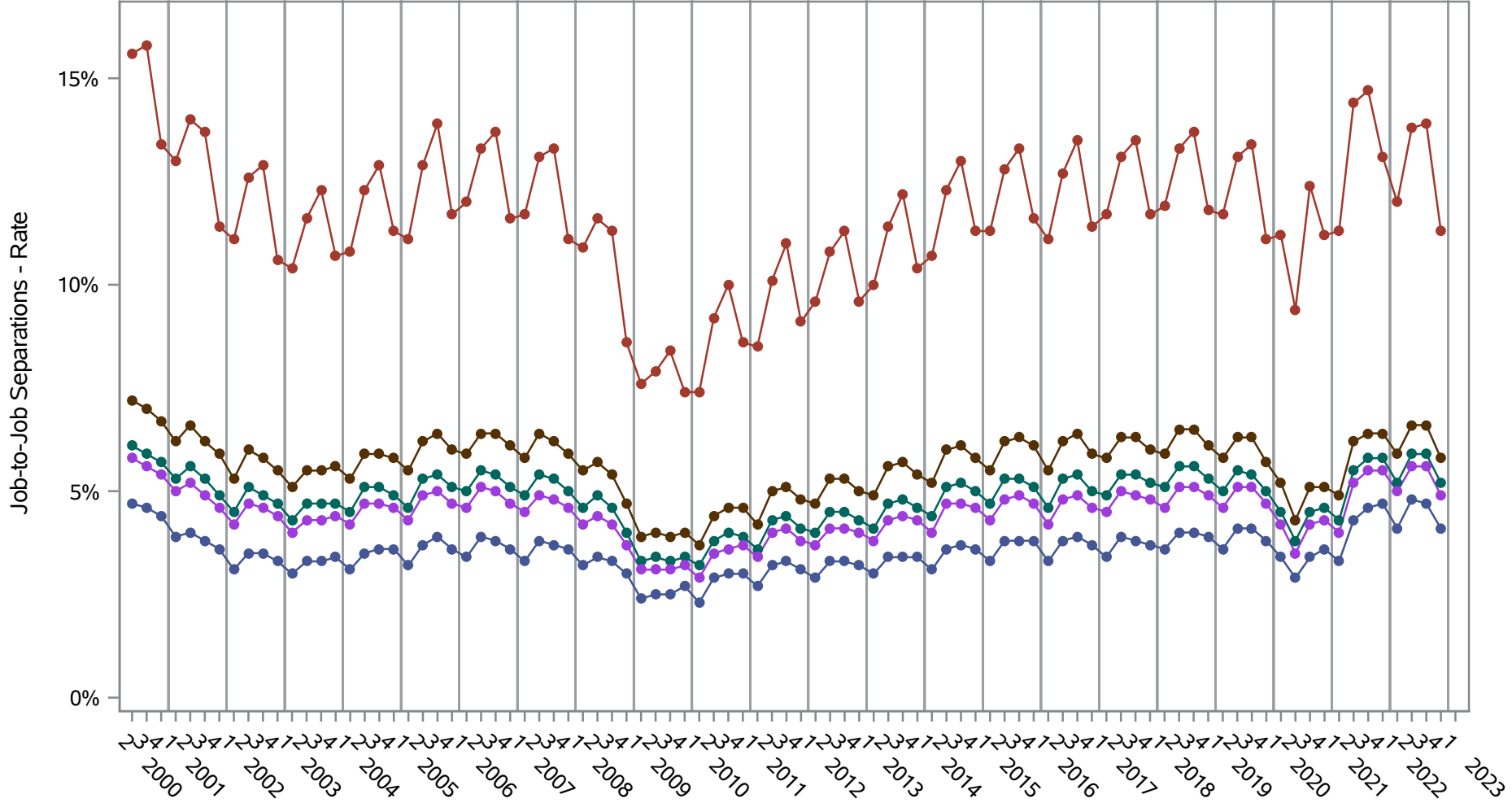

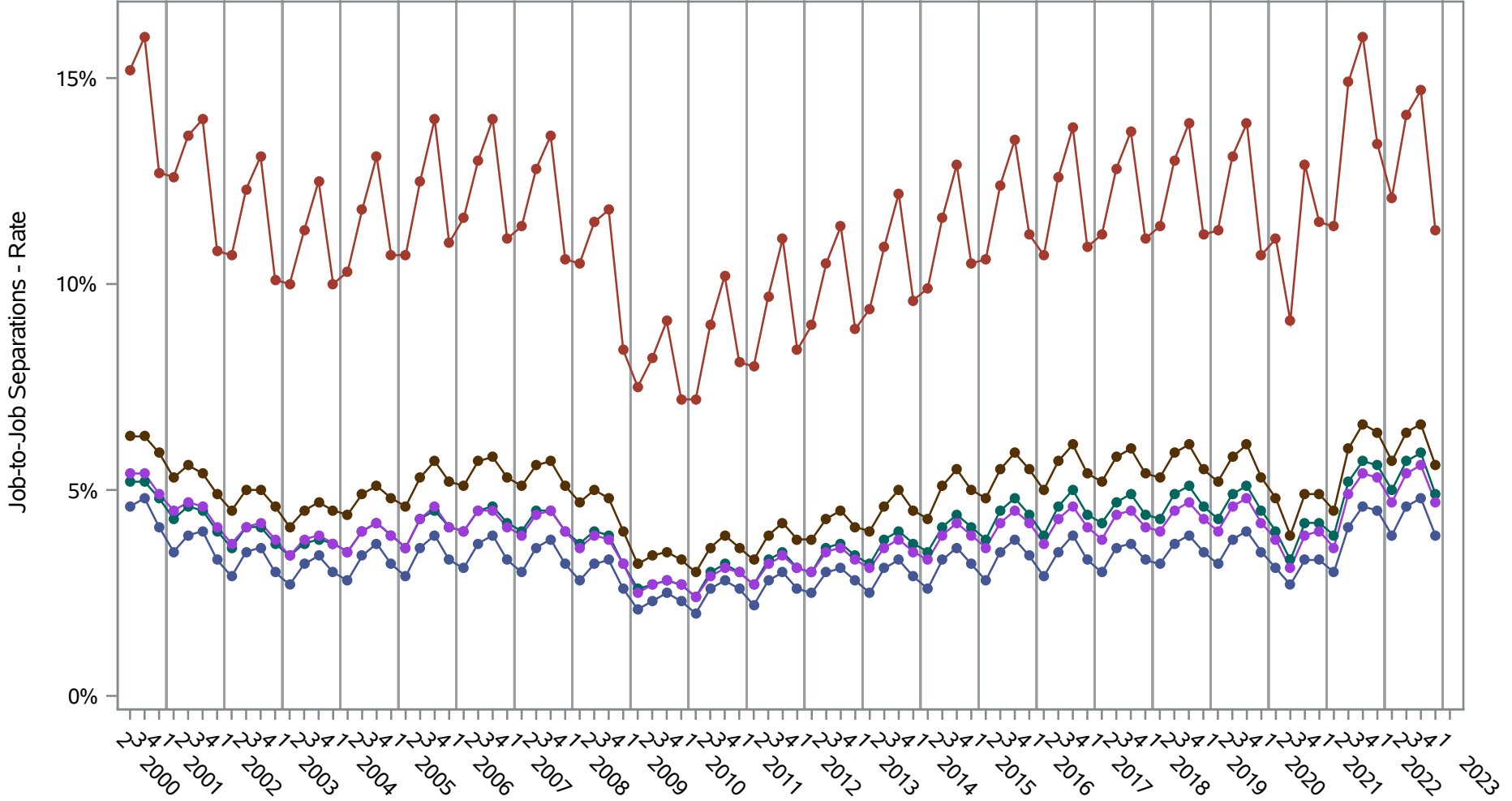

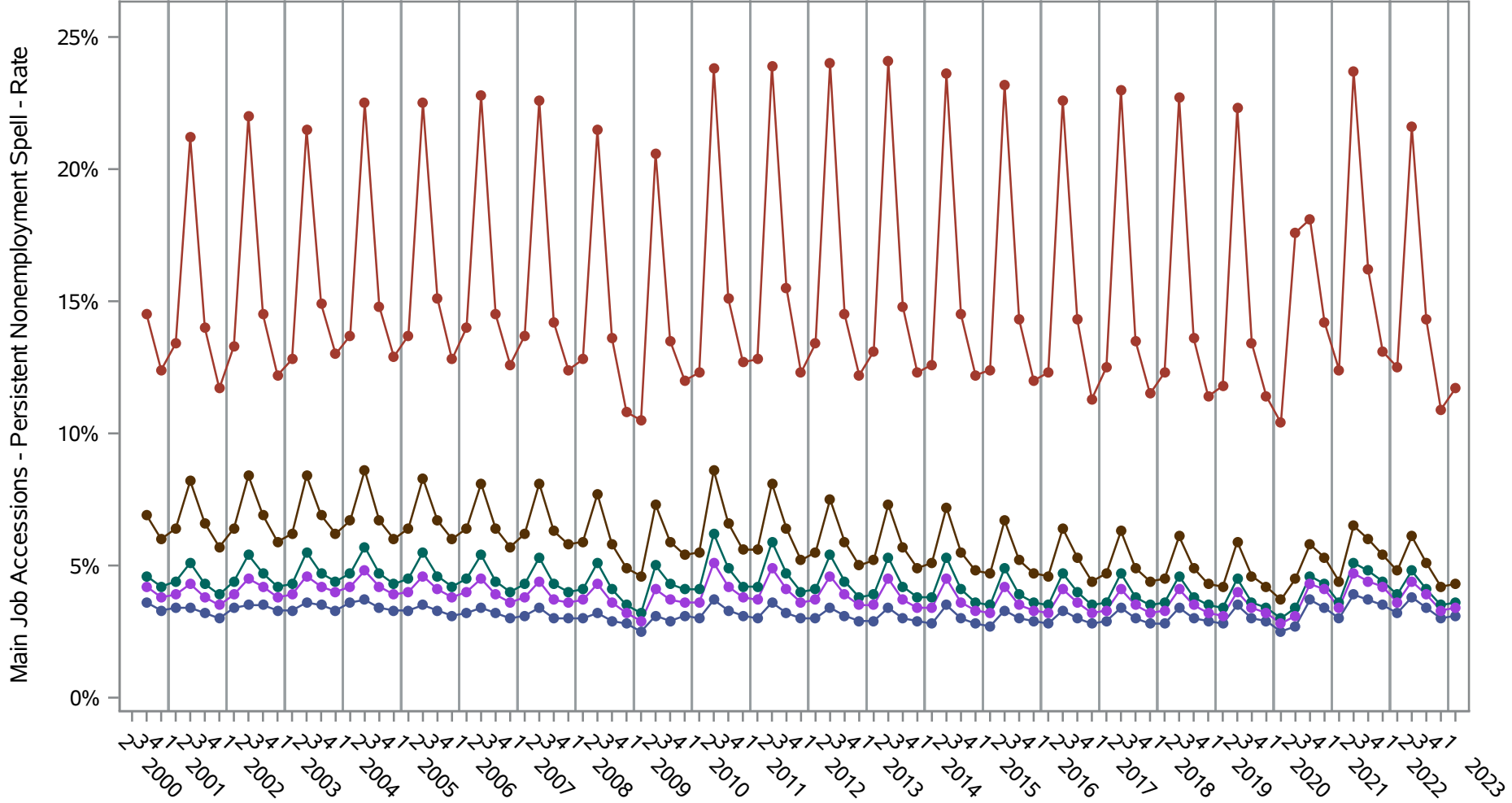

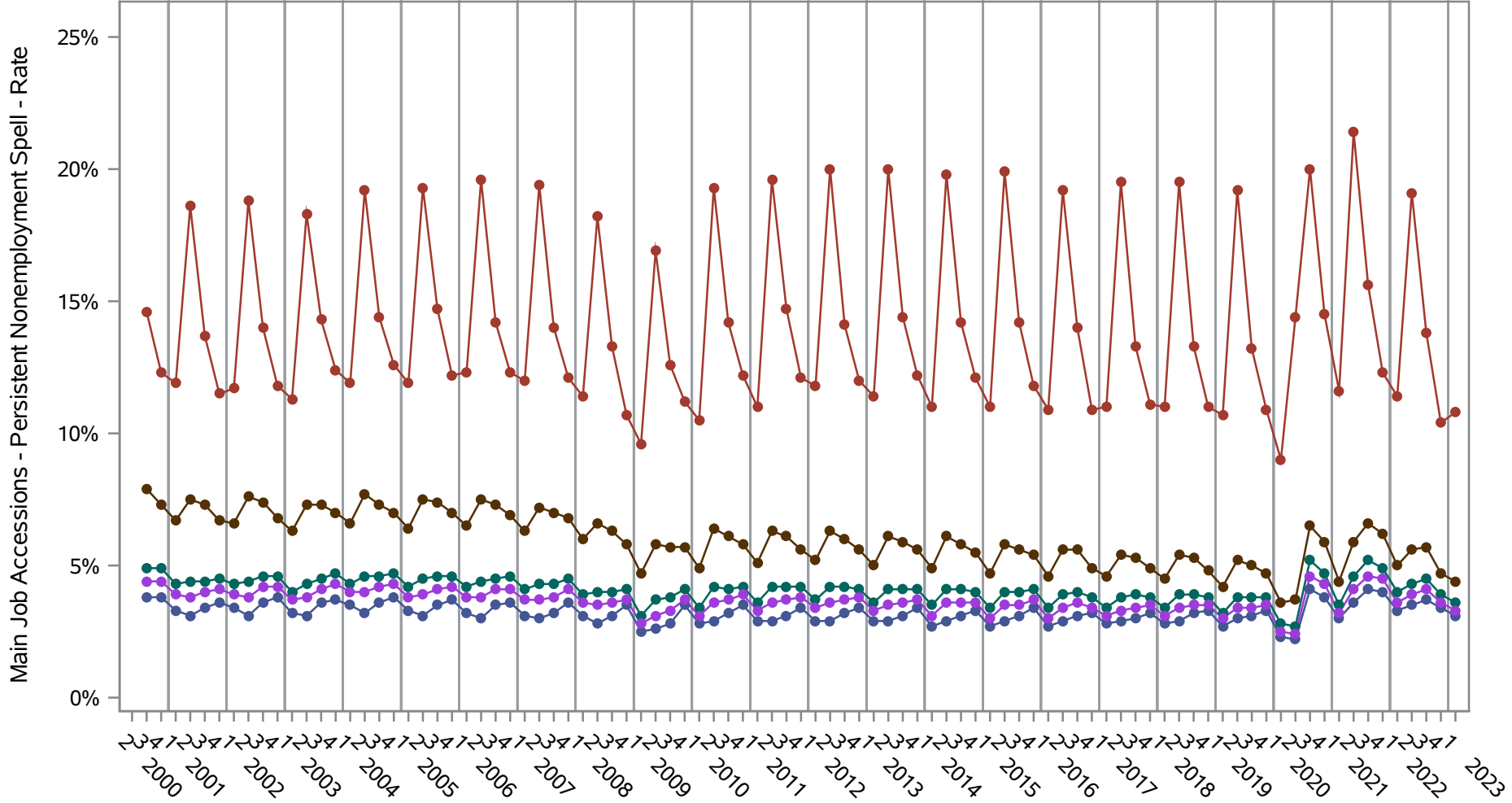

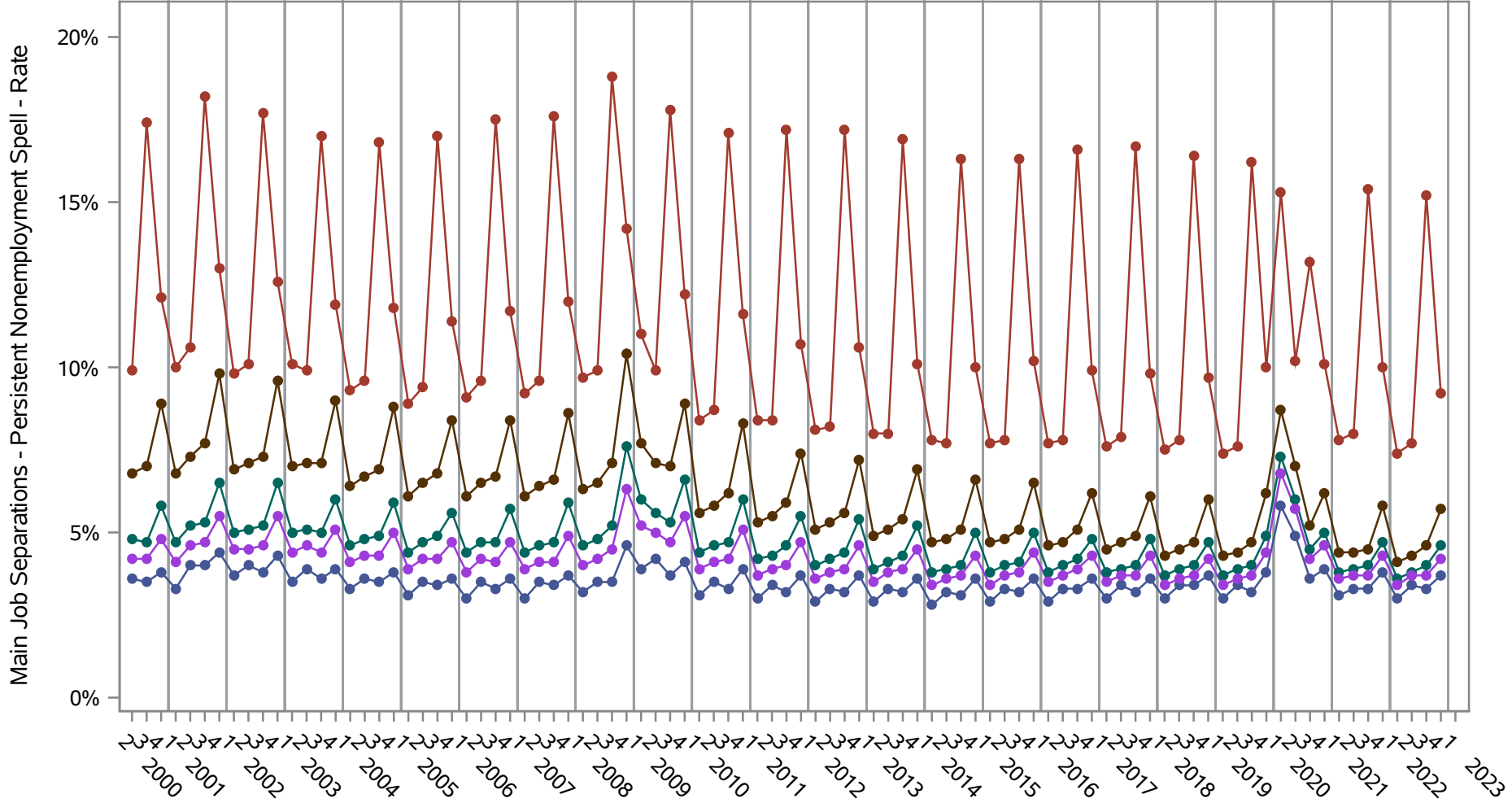

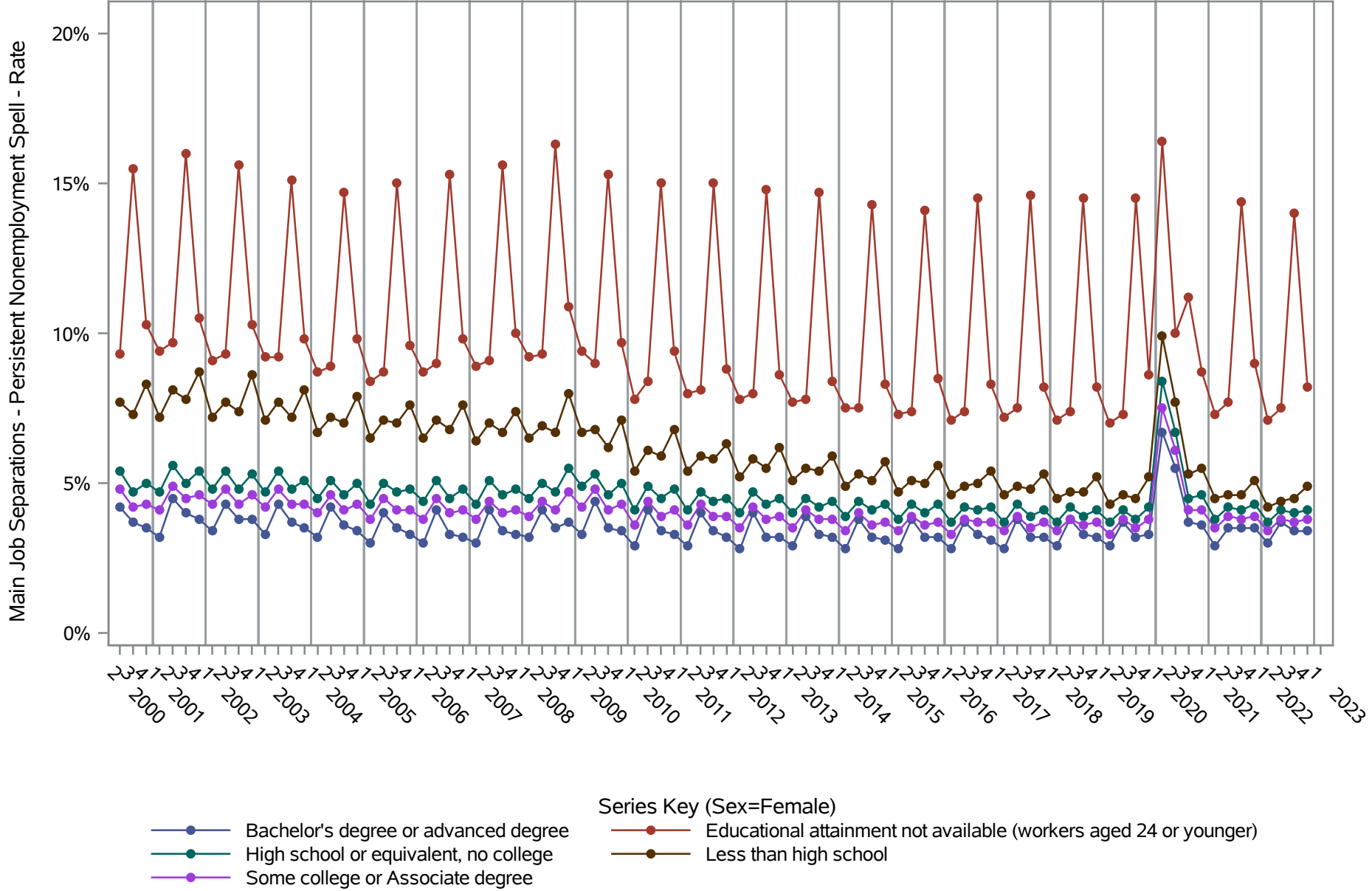

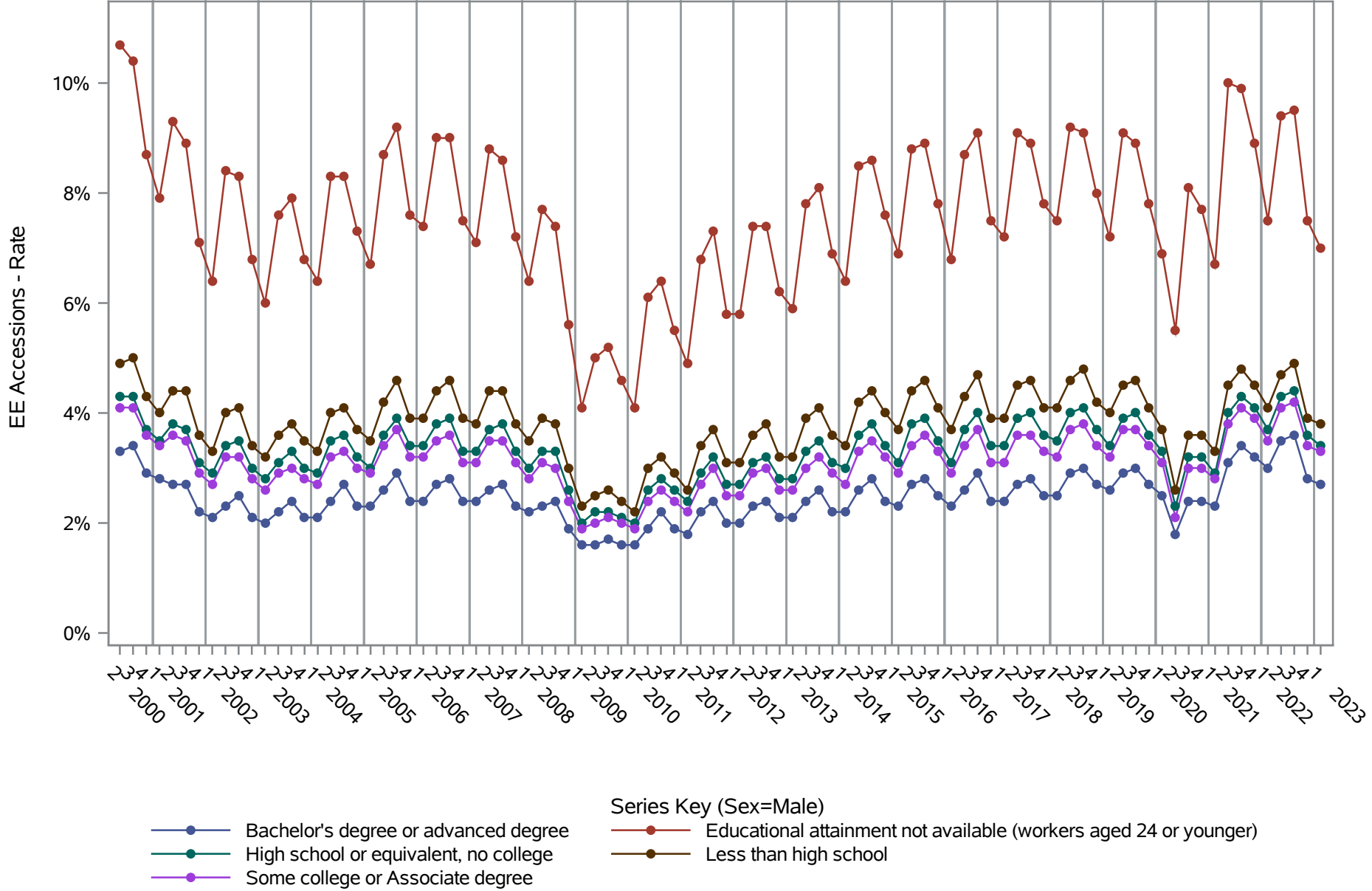

## Main Job Separations - Persistent Nonemployment Spell (Not Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (2 of 2) Sex=Female



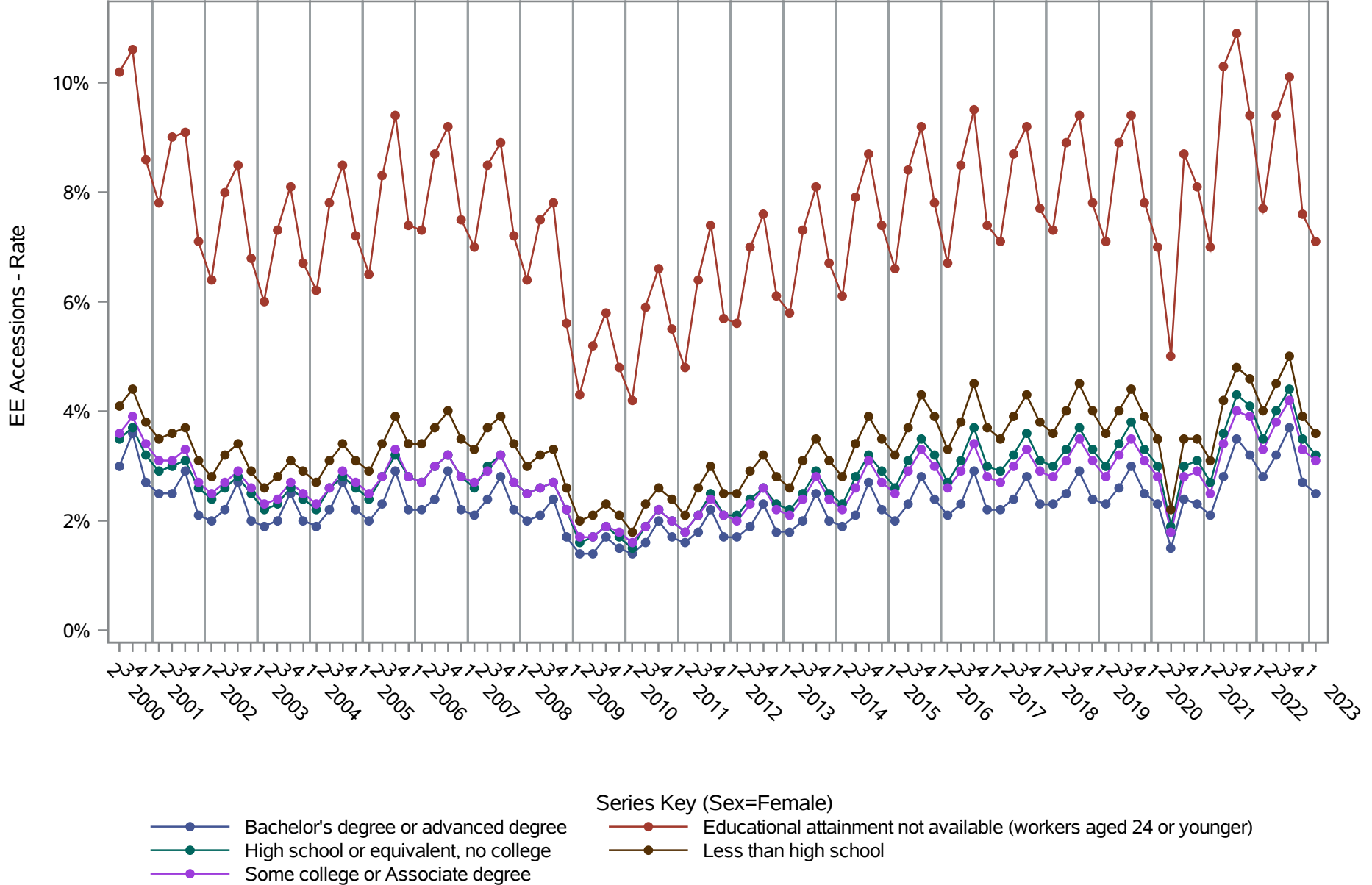

*by Sex and Education (1 of 2) Sex=Male*



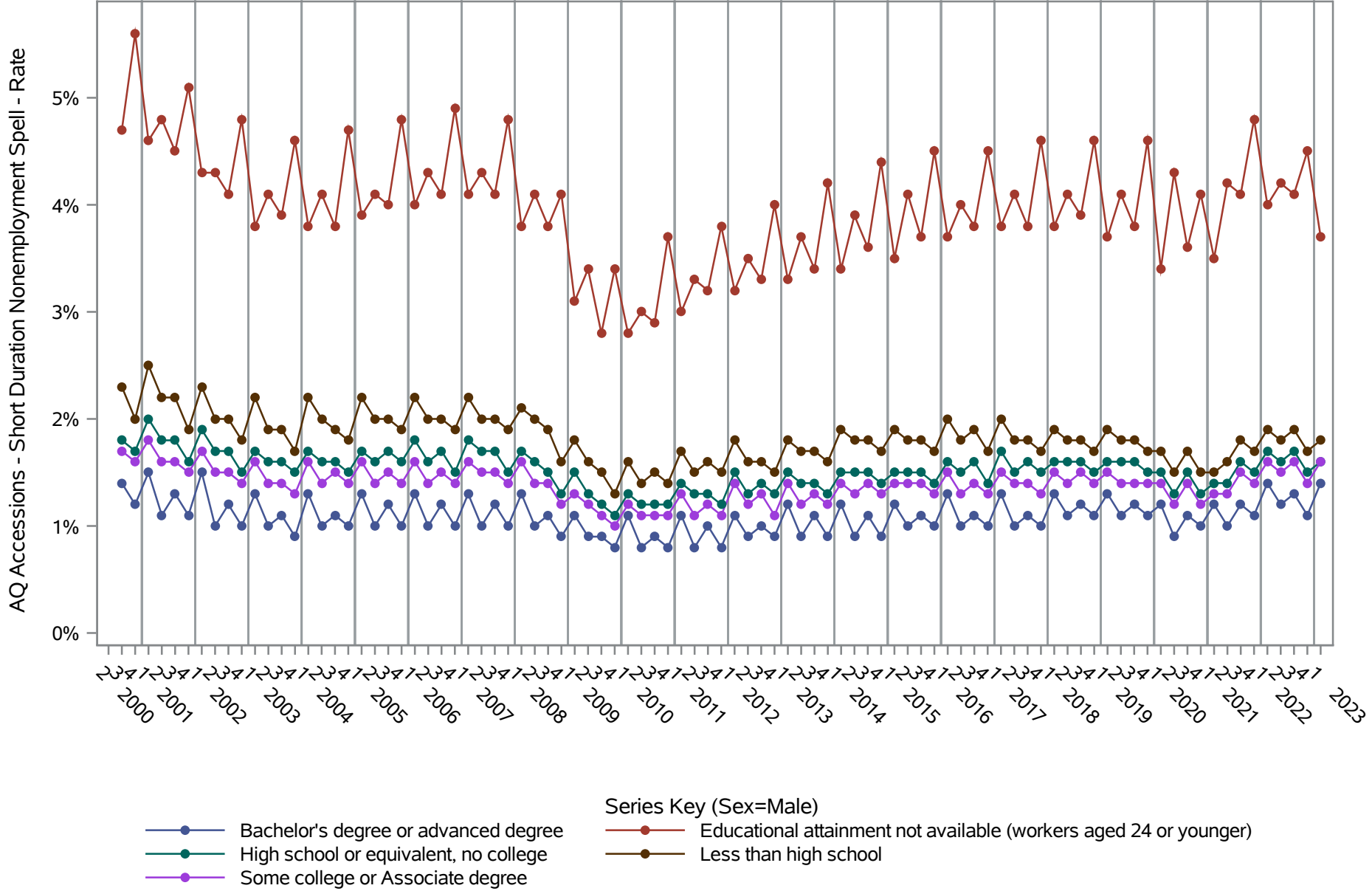

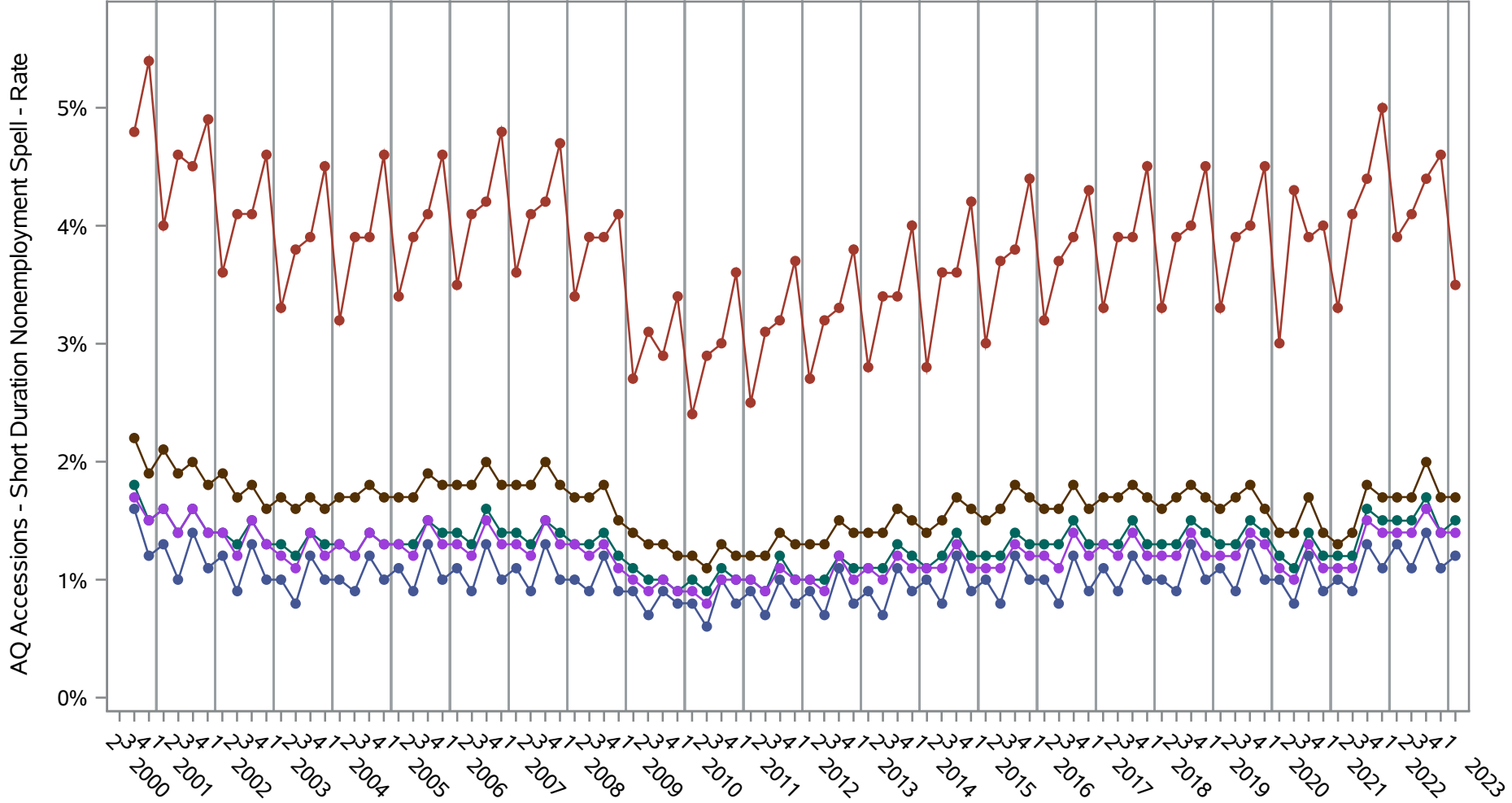

### AQ Accessions - Short Duration Nonemployment Spell (Not Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (2 of 2) Sex=Female



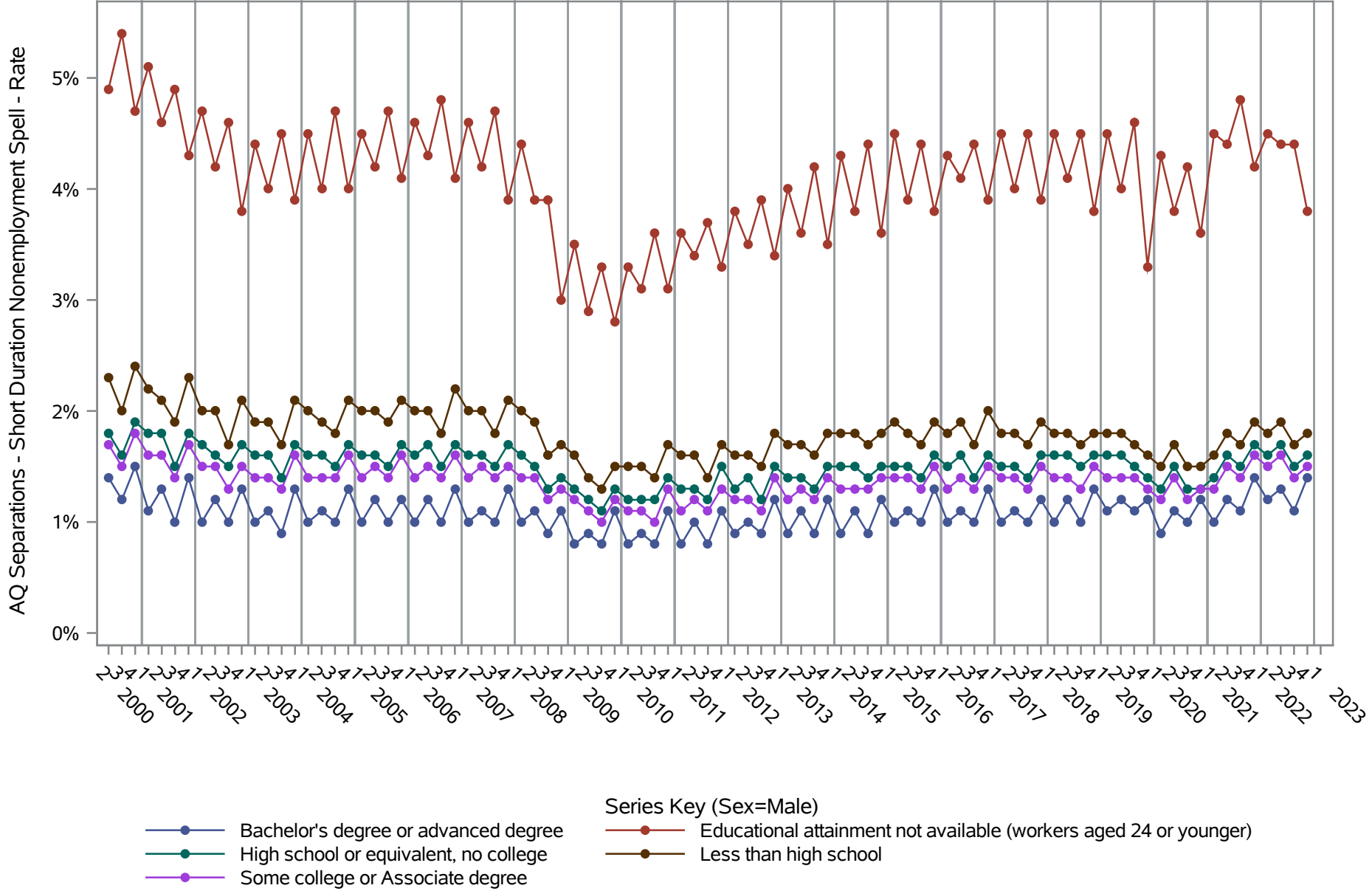

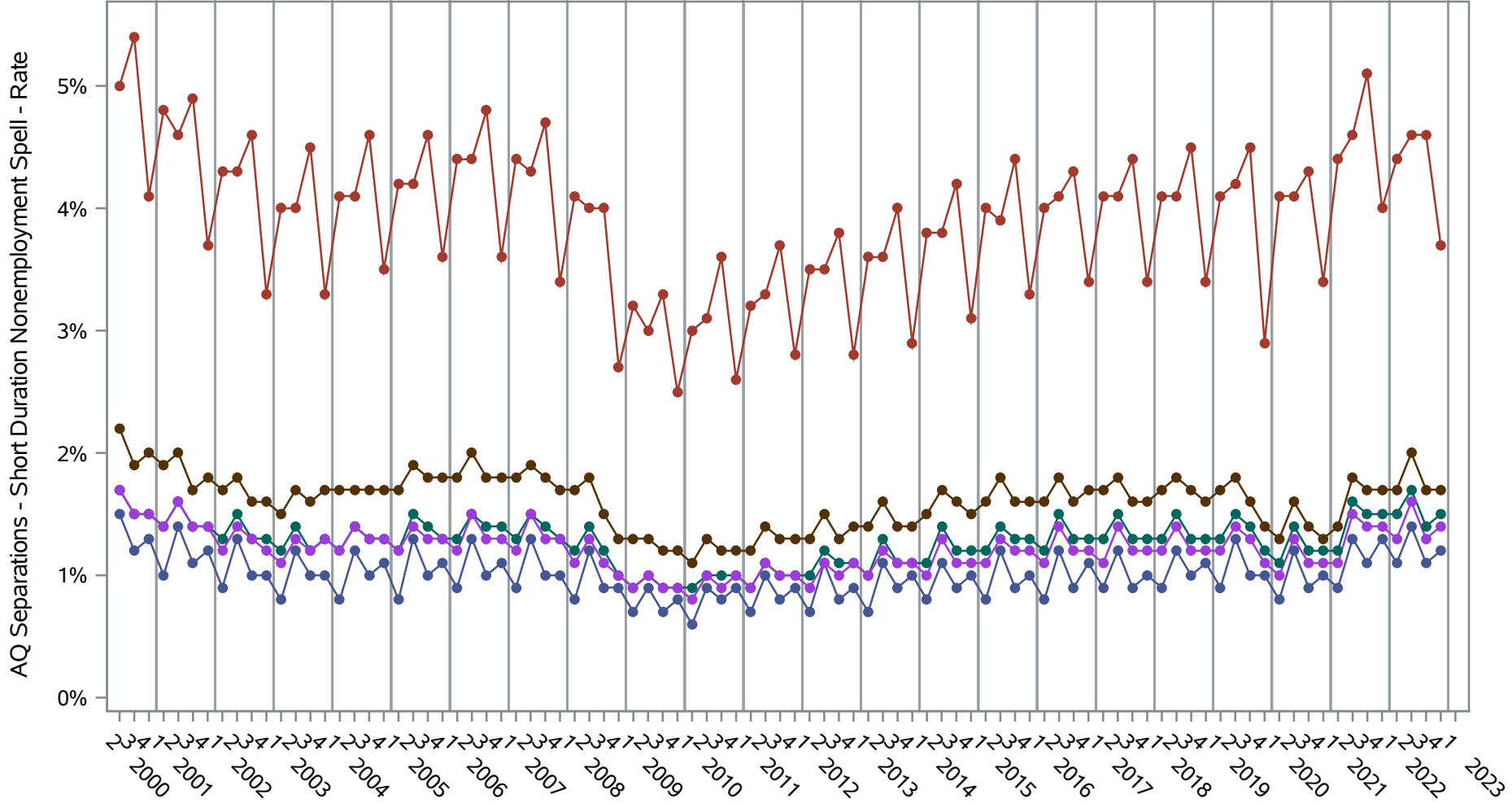
## AQ Separations - Short Duration Nonemployment Spell (Not Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (1 of 2) Sex=Male
