



- Downtown largely zoned commercial;


Industrial Sanctuaries in Portland

Portland's Comprehensive Plan Policy 2.14:


Provide industrial sanctuaries. Encourage the growth of industrial activities in the city by preserving industrial land primarily for manufacturing purposes.

Why Protect Land for Industrial Activities?

- critical for economic vitality;
- jobs have above average wages;
- greater economic multiplier effects than other sectors;
- maintain competitive edge in response to need for industrial space.







Comparison of Workers Profiles

- Size: Downtown workforce (19% of City) nearly four times the Sanctuary (5% of City);
- Job Density: Downtown (93 jobs/acre) nearly 5 times Sanctuary (19 jobs/acre);
- Age: nearly identical age distribution. areas mimic the City's workforce;
- Earnings: more higher income jobs Downtown (53%) than in Sanctuary (36%). Downtown higher than City as a whole.




Where Do Industrial Sanctuary Workers Making \$1,250/mo or Less Live?








Where Do Downtown Workers Making \$1,250/mo or Less Live?



Where Do Industrial Sanctuary Workers Making More Than \$3,333/mo Live?





Concluding Observations

- "job mix" in sanctuary is distinct;
- sanctuary workers differ in size and earnings;
- workers similar in age distribution;
- ▶ less than 50% of workers from both areas live in the City;
- > over 60% of residents in the two areas work in the City.




